- The emphasis behind this league is to provide the opportunity for archers to learn, develop & improve their shooting techniques for field archery.
- All regions are welcome to participate. (eg. Scotland, Wales, N Ireland & England) All you have to do is find where a field archery club is prepared to lay-on a FITA field 12 marked course (FITA rule book1 - Rule 4.5.3.8)
I hope clubs will be prepared to encourage archers to attend and enjoy themselves.

- **It is the archer's responsibility to register their wish to ATTEND direct with the club contact. (Some clubs are limited on numbers)**
 - **Each club will probably charge a nominal shooting fee, please check when you register with the club that you intend to attend.**
 - **Stout footwear and warm suitable clothing is always advisable.**
 - **It is the archers responsibility to check what facilities are available at the club, e.g. Practise targets & Portaloo's may not be available as you would expect at a fully organised tournament.**
 - For SAT NAV users, the nearest Postcode is provided close to the club entrance.
DO NOT disturb the residents who live at these addresses.
 - If you have not attended before always contact the club for specific instructions.
 - If this is your first taste of field archery, tell the club contact and they will try their best to arrange for an experienced field archer to assist your introduction.

- In addition to this - if the archers would like to submit their scores a league table shall be created for each of the bow disciplines. The results shall be published on the GNAS field website. www.gnasfield.co.uk
- For the league to work please pass on your scores to Shaun Duggan by using the excel file named "WFAL submission form.xls", this will be available on the gnasfield web site. The deadline for your scores is the last day of each month. Please email them to duggan555@waitrose.com

Scoring / Racking system explained:

1. The league ranking will consist of taking the best score shot by an archer during the months of October, November, January & February. (A total of 4 scores) The archer on any 12 target course with the highest accumulated score shall have the highest ranking.
2. 'WILD-CARD' If any scores are shot during the months of December or March, then the best score can be used as a 'wild-card' entry to replace one lower score from Oct, Nov, Jan or Feb months.
3. Archers with less than 4 results will still be listed in order of their accumulated total.
4. The score's entered shall be for a single marked unit (12 targets).
5. A double round (2 x loops) will be entered on the spreadsheet as two results. (1xAM + 1xPM)
6. Recognised Bow disciplines shall be: **Recurve, Compound U/L, Compound Ltd. (RED Pegs)**
Barebow Recurve, Traditional, Longbow, Compound Barebow. (BLUE Pegs)
Juniors shall be added below the seniors and their age category marked.
7. It is the responsibility of the archer to ensure that their score is submitted to Shaun Duggan, league organiser for inclusion.
