The shoot down format is based on a shoot held at Pacific Archery the evening before the World Archery Festival shoot in Vegas. It consists of a qualification round which will 'seed' archers into flights according to score, and a head to head element to determine the winner of each flight. The flight winner is the last one standing!

**Rules**

**Qualification**

First archers will all take part in a qualification round consisting of 36 arrows at 20 yards on a 60cm face). This will be used to rank archers into flights (the number of flights will be determined by the number of archers). This will be done by dividing the number of archers shooting by 4 and then cutting depending on where they are ranked (eg 20 archers shooting archers ranked 1 – 5 will be in flight 1, 6 – 10 flight 2, 11 – 15 flight 3 and 16 – 20 flight 4).

**Shutdown**

Each flight will then shoot down until a winner is determined in that flight. In each flight the bottom 2 placed archers will shoot a 6 arrow match eg 6 archers in a flight archer 6 and 5 will shoot off against each other. The winner stays on and will shoot against 4<sup>th</sup> place. This will carry on until the last man is standing. That person will be deemed the flight winner.
