- Dress Regulations (GNAS) for Target Archery will be enforced.
- No Substitutes allowed.
- Camping/caravanning is permissible at a charge of £5-50 per night. Please include this charge with your entry fee.

- Target list/results will be e-mailed in Excel format if e-mail address given.
- Will last year's Trophy winners please return them (cleaned) on or before the day of the tournament.

- There will be 4 archers per target shooting in two details.
- Veterans are Ladies over 60 and Gentlemen over 65.
- A novice is an archer in their first year of affiliation.
- **Archers with a disability should inform the Tournament Organiser, at the time of entry, should they wish to stay on the shooting line. Every effort will then be made to place only 3 archers on the target.**

All archers will be eligible to compete for the Open awards and those archers who are members of the Northern Counties Archery Society will, be eligible to compete for the "Local Archers" trophies and medals.
