Unfortunately we have been unable to secure the site at New College, Pontefract so we have decided to hold the competition at our normal shooting ground at Horbury, Wakefield.

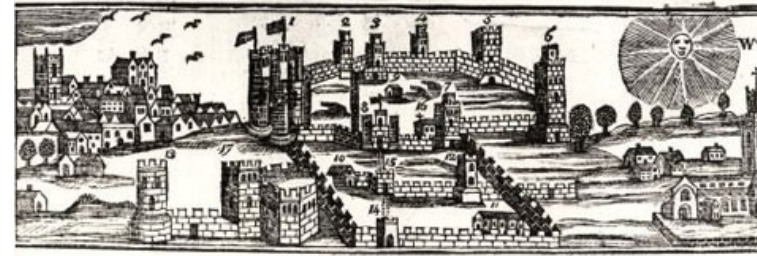
Whilst the new venue may not have the historic significance as Pontefract Castle, I do hope that you will continue to support the event and have a thoroughly enjoyable shoot.

Continue on A642 until you see sign for Horbury Junction and turn left into Daw Lane, then immediate right into Southfield Lane.

Turn left off Southfield Lane, over the railway line, then right to Slazenger's Sports Club.
