Directions

MI Junction 41, turn towards Wakefield on the A650. Cross straight over two roundabouts, keeping to the dual carriageway.

Turn right at the third roundabout (passing a large Pub on the left)
Turn left at the first set of lights (filter lane)

Crest a low hill to traffic signals in right hand lane, and then turn left 50 yards (ish) after the traffic lights, into the school.

Head through the school and the car park is to the right
